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For students and faculty affiliated with Sorbonne Nouvelle University

Install Eduroam

- Go to the site <https://cat.eduroam.org>
- Click on the button to download ("télécharger") the installer.
- In the menu that appears, select « **Université Paris 3 - Sorbonne Nouvelle** ».
- Follow the steps to download the file.
- Open the file you just downloaded.
- Follow the steps up to the stage where it asks for your login credentials.
- Enter your login credentials (see the next section to figure out what they are).

Once the installation is complete, Eduroam is configured on your machine and you should be able to connect to it in future at any institution that uses Eduroam.

Your Eduroam credentials

Your login ID is the same as your login for iSorbonne, that is, an identifier followed by @univ-paris3.fr (For students the identifier is your university student number, otherwise it may be the first letter of your first name followed by your last name, or something else, there are variations, but it is whatever you enter to access iSorbonne).

Examples : 12345678@univ-paris3.fr , jdupont@univ-paris3.fr, etc.

Your password is also the same as for iSorbonne.

For CNRS employees

To activate your Eduroam credentials

If you have never used CNRS Eduroam, you will need to activate your credentials.

Go to <https://eduroam.cnrs.fr/index.fr.php> and click on « activer mon compte eduroam » (activate my Eduroam account).

This will take you to a page that asks for your Janus codes to identify you. Once you have been identified, you will receive a login with the following format: two letters, two digits, then two more letters. You will also be given a password made up of four words in lowercase separated by spaces.

Note the login and password carefully as these are your Eduroam login credentials.

Install Eduroam

- Go to the site <https://cat.eduroam.org>
- Click on the button to download the installer.
- In the menu that appears, locate « **CNRS – Délégation Aquitaine** », then select it.
Note that you really have to choose **Aquitaine**, regardless of which CNRS group you belong to, regardless of which delegation you are affiliated with.
- Follow the steps to download the file.
- Open the file you just downloaded.
- Follow the steps up to the point where it asks for your credentials.
- Enter your login credentials (see the next section to figure out what they are).

Once the installation is complete, Eduroam is configured on your machine and you should be able to connect to it in future at any institution that uses Eduroam.

Your Eduroam credentials

Your login looks like this : ab12cd@eduroam.cnrs.fr

Your password is a sequence of four words with the format : word1 word2 word3 word4

For those with other affiliations

Install Eduroam

- Go to the site <https://cat.eduroam.org>
- Click on the button to download the installer.

- In the menu that appears, locate **your home institution**, then select it. (For example if you are affiliated with the Université de Lille, choose Université de Lille)
- Follow the steps to download the file.
- Open the file you just downloaded.
- Follow the steps up to the point where it asks for your credentials.
- Enter your login credentials (see the next section to figure out what they are).

Once the installation is complete, Eduroam is configured on your machine and you should be able to connect to it in future at any institution that uses Eduroam.

Your Eduroam credentials

You will need to consult your home institution's web site to see how your login and password are determined, and if you need to create an account first before installing Eduroam.
